- Provides a more equitable playing field for the next generation through inter-cultural exchanges at a multitude of levels and through a variety of means

eduWeavers' workshops allow schools a unique opportunity to be exposed to the eduWeavers' teaching and learning philosophy and then *develop tangible goals and a working game plan* to meet those goals within the context of an engaging, interactive, team-building experience.

eduWeavers' philosophy is equally applicable to internal school-specific relationships (like a buddy program or a social and emotional learning program) or to a local/global relationship with another school or community group.
